

FAQs for the Montly Meeting

1. **What is the significant of son of a Khalifa in comparision to khilafat?**

One objection on the truth of Hazrat Masih Maud (as) is often raised that he was not an *Arabi* or not from *Aal-e-Rasool*. Allah Talah says in the Holy Quran [62:5] *That is Allah's grace; He bestows it on whom He pleases; and Allah is the Master of immense grace*. Khilafat is not kinship. The propcecy of Hazrat Muhammad Mustafa (saw) was regarding the establishment of Khilafat *through* the Prophethood, since the prophethood is based on Allah's Grace (mentioned above) so is the Khilafat that follows it.

2. **What is the need of a Mujaddad when a Khilafat is here to guide us?**

Under the sole leadership of Khalifat-ul-Masih, there is no need for any other authority. The prophecy of Hazrat Muhammad Mustfa (saw) about Mujadadeen clearly speaks for the time before the advent of the *Messiah* in the Ummah where there was a need to keep reviving the true message of Islam. Since the Messiah has appeared and the system of Divinely guided Khilafat has been established, need for a separate mujaddid is not there anymore. This question has been answered in detail by Hadhrat Musleh Maud (ra). The status of khilafat is much higher than mujaddad

3. **What do this group (followers of Mirza rafi Ahmad) have to offer Ahmadiyyat? Anything positive beyond what Islam and Massih e Maud as has already shown us?**

The focus of such groups has always been to create divide among the followers of the Promised Messiah (as). They bring out the negative (don't pay chanda, don't talk about baits, don't believe in khilafat, don't believe in 'love for all hatred for none). If not this then do what? Do they have any system to follow?

4. **Is this the first such group? What was the fate of such groups in the past?**

One of the main purposes of the institution of Khilafat is to establish the unity and peace among the community of faithful. [24:56] *And that He will surely give them in exchange security and peace after their fear*. Anything that is done to disrupt the unity and peace of a Jamat is against the true spirit of a community. Such groups are created out of the desperation, jealousy and animosity. Lahori Jamat had also tried to create the divide in Jamat, by not accepting the Divinely appointed Khalifa, however where are they today? Propagation of any message needs a structure and a system, however, it is always the TRUTH of the message that prevails and is behind the progress of that system and structure. Opponents of Khilafat have always tried to undermine the supremacy of this Divine institution, which is the TRUTH and is mentioned in the Holy Quran, hence they have always failed.

5. **Why did Mirza Rafi Ahmad did bait at the hand of Hadhrat Khalifatul Massih V (aba)?**

Doing Ba'ait a the hand of Hazrat Khalifa-tul-Masih (aba) speaks for itself. The title some are attributing to him was never claimed by Miza Rafi Ahmad sb.

6. **Hadhur led his janaza and had good things to say about him. Are these people really doing a favor to Mirza Rafi Ahmad sb by creating all this distraction out of nothing?**

7. **Mirza Rafi Ahmad sb never claimed to be a Mujaddid. So essentially they are defining Mirza Rafi Ahmad sb as something he never claimed. Has something similar happened before? Jesus and diviinity? Hadhrat Ali and Shiite claim?**

Hazrat Ali (ra) did ba'ait at the hands of all three Khulafa prior to him, yet the Shiites claim that he was deserving of being the first Khalifa of Hazrat Muhammad Mustafa (saw). Such groups are not even sincere with whom they are promoting (in this case Mirza Rafi Ahmad sb). They have their own ulterior motives.
