

"Nay, whoever submits himself completely to Allah, and is the doer of good, shall have his reward with his Lord. No fear shall come upon such, neither shall they grieve" (Chapter 2, verse 113).

- Here the words 'whoever submits himself completely to Allah' mean that someone submits to the Divinity of Allah with complete humility. They devote their life, possessions, honor, and in fact all that they have for the sake of Allah.
- In short, the real meaning of Islam demands the submission (Waqf) of our life in the way of Allah.



The Promised Messiah (as) on Waqf



The Promised Messiah (as) states:

• "Practical corroboration is essential with verbal promise. Therefore, it is necessary that you devote your life in the way of Allah. This is true Islam and this is the purpose for which I have been sent. The true objective of Islam is to create many 'Ibrahims'. Therefore, it should be the endeavor of everybody to become 'Ibrahim'. I truly say to you, do not worship the saints but become a saint yourself! Do not worship spiritual guides but become a guide yourself!"

Waqf-e-Arzi Initiation



- On March 12th, 1966, Hazrat Khalifatul Masih III (rh) introduced the Waqf-e-Arzi project. The purpose of this project is to promote the learning and teaching of the Holy Qur'an as well as imparting religious knowledge to Jamaat members. The scope of the initiative has been since extended to various other benefitting mankind.
- The <u>expenses</u> during the Waqf-e-Arzi should be born by the volunteer (especially travel).
- While initially the <u>duration</u> was intended for at least **2 weeks**, also shorter Waqf-e-Arzi for just 3 days are possible.

Potential Tasks for Waqf-e-Arzi



- Conduct classes on Holy Qur'an
- Tabligh
- Conduct Atfal/Nasirat classes
- Promote Tarbiyyat of members
- Dars- Qur'an/Hadith/Malfuzaat

- Assist Local Jama'at President/Murabbi
- Administrative work with an auxiliary or Jamaat department
- Waqar-e-Amal at Jalsa



Waqf-e-Arzi with Humanity First

- Volunteer during disaster relief efforts in US and abroad
- Assistance with project reporting (including video and photography),
 e.g. Water for Life, schools, etc. mostly in Africa and South America
- Vocational centers in Africa: Teach English for 1 week
- Feasibility study for new projects, like school construction in developing country (architecture/engineering background)
- Assistance with creation of websites

- Fazl-e-Omar Hospital and Tahir Heart Institute, Rabwah, Pakistan.
 - "Ahmadi doctors from here should travel to Rabwah with the exclusive intention and objective of serving in our hospital." Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V (aba)
- Nasir Hospital Guatemala Humanity First
- Medical Mission Trips Central America, Africa also non-doctors can serve in logistics
- Duration: 1-2 weeks
